A) ACADEMIC REPORT OF 2016:

This year we started the new session of 2016 from April 19th 2016. First two days we managed the school, our rooms and class rooms with the help of local staffs and students. We started the session with our project staffs for some weeks since the Government teachers join the school some weeks lately. All together according to our school and Government registration we have seventy five students this year but regarding the regular attendance, we have sixty five to seventy one daily. Some small students from the E.C.D couldn't come to school daily as their parents moved to some other places for summer camp. We ended this session on 25th of October. Every year we conduct two examinations of each fifty marks. We conduct the first Examination in the month of July and second in October. As usual this year also we come out with good and satisfactory result from our students. All my staffs have done their job very well as per their ability and knowledge.

B) NAME OF THE TEACHERS

Pema Wangyal, Dawa Wangmo, Passang Dhadul, and Kunsang Lhamo are through the project. Whereas Passang Dhadul teaches Tibetans and Health in seventh period, Pema Wangyal Teaches Mathematic and Health in seventh period, Kunsang Lhamo teaches Science and Health in seventh period, Dawa Wangmo teaches English and Health in seventh period. Among these Teachers Passang Dhadul, Dawa Wangmo and Kunsang Lhamo are ex-students of Saldang School. Beside these we have three teachers provided by the District Education Office (DEO) from Dunai. Mr. Gyanu Gurung is the Head Master and he was engaged with Government works regarding the school and Administrative works of school most of the time, Mr Manlal Budha is the Assistant Head master and he teaches Nepali and look after E.C.D with Nepali. Mr Pratap Rokaya teaches Nepali Social Study. We have One E.C.D teacher Karma Chuneu whose salary is provided by DEO, VDC and our project part by part and she teaches Health in seventh period to class one. All together we have eight teachers in our school for this academic session.

C) STUDENTS ATTENDENCE DURING THE ACADEMIC SESSION:

This year we have seventy five (75) students at the beginning. Among them seventeen (17) students were admitted this year. Most of the students have given 100% attendance during this session. Few students couldn't give full attendance because of some household works as well as illness and moving to other places for summer camp. There are eighteen (18) students in Nursery Class that is E.C D, where sixteen children were admitted this year. There are nineteen (19) students in class K.G with one drop out. Eleven (11) students in class one, Five (5) students in class Two, Five (5) students in class Three, Four (4) students in class Four, Five (5) students in class Five and seven (7) students in class Six. This year we don't have students from Namdo and Karang School. We have four drop outs where some of them have joined the monastery as monks in Kathmandu and Namdroling Monastery in India.

D) DAILY ROUTINE OF THE SCHOOL:

- 8:30 am – 9:00 am (Morning Prayer)
- 9:00 am – 12:10 pm (Morning Classes)
- 12:10 pm – 1:10 pm (Lunch Break)
- 1:10 pm – 4:00 pm (Afternoon Classes)
- 4:00pm – 4:15 pm (Evening Prayer)

Regarding the time table it's always same as usual and this year we combined the class three and four together and run the session 2016. It was bit difficult but run the school very well.

E) EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:

Regarding the extracurricular activities, we teach Tibetan dance, Nepali Dance, simple painting, and drawing. Some time we have movie time in a small computer room with projector. This year I am happy that Passang Dhadul gave basic computer knowledge to students of class six and five every Friday after lunch. Kunsang Lhamo, Passang Dhadul and Dawa Wangmo taught Tibetan dance and Nepali dance to the children. We have bought ten sets of Nepali dancing dress for girls and boys for the school.

F) EXAMINATION REPORT:

Every year we conduct two exams of full marks 40 for the first half and 60 full marks for the second half exam which becomes 100 full marks in total. We have taken the first half annual examination from 17th of July to 24th of July and most of the students have done very well. And second half annual examination was conducted on 16th of October and we have final result on 25th of October.

Along with this I have made the tabulation sheet of each of the classes and all the details of the examination.

G) THE WORK OF SCHOOL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE:

This year also there was some changes in school management committee since there were some changes in norms and rules in the District Education Office through Office of Nepal Education. As promised by the inspection officers of District Education office last year, they have set a two room toilet for boys and girls separately but not finished yet. I hope may come to use next year only.

H) VILLAGER'S CONTRIBUTION FOR THE SCHOOL:

As contribution from the villagers, 50 kg of firewood is always there.

This year, I am able to make a green house of 25" by 24" big enough for winter class for the children and vegetables for staffs in summer. It was request of winter Teacher for I am happened to introduce with Sir David from Canada who visited Saldang School during his trekking. With his money I am also setting the wall of the school with bigger play ground. I have requested for the lower part of the open ground for the school. The wall will be 2 fit stone base with two or three steps of clay wall and on top again one fit stone keeping all the lower side block inside the wall. Now the works is under progress and I have requested winter teachers for the photos of the construction. When I get them I will send them to all the sponsors too. As being the coordinator and responsible person, I am trying my best to make the school better and child friendly with the help of precious donors, sponsors and well wishers.
