Over all review report of the year 2018 ACADEMIC REPORT OF 2018:

Summer session of the year 2018 was started on 22nd of April 2018 and ended the session on 26th of October 2018. We enrolled this session with 87 total number of students. It was a good and successful enough session with the good support and help from our valued sponsors, good and cooperative staffs and of course the villagers with the local leaders. During this session we welcomed some guests from Government as well as winter school sponsors, attended some schools programs.

This year we have done infrastructural improvements within the school premises. We have reroofed the school class block with Green house plastic and have made to room new blocks attached with the old class section blocks. And there was a introduction of new syllabus of Nepali language for the classes from 1 to 3 which is designed by Ministry of Education and supported by USAID program.

As usual, this year also we have taken two examinations one with 40 marks and the other with 60 marks which in combined makes 100.

We have found that most of the students have done good and there are some who haven't done good enough. And the SMC along with the teachers have decided to let them repeat the classes and make them work harder next year. In over all we have good and satisfactory result from all the classes. This year we have three students coming Kathmandu to join the Hostel for their further study.

From the above list of teachers, Gyanu Gurung is the headmaster, he is responsible for all the administration of the school with each and every government works. He taught the new syllabus of the Gov for the classes 1-3 after having two weeks of training in Dunai by the DEO and he is supposed to guide other two Gov teachers as well.

Manlal Budha taught Nepali language lesson for the classes KG, four, five and six. At the end he went to attend the Government examination. Nishana Budha took the Nepali Social classes from 1 to six.

Pema wangyal took the science class for all and is also responsible for all the administration of the school in the absence of Headmaster and also responsible for dealing with the guests of the school. Kunsang Lhamo took Environment, physical and health lessons, DawaWangmo took english lessons, Pema Tseten took Tibetan lessons and Dawa Dhondup took Mathematic lessons. Karma Chuneyi is responsible for taking care of all the new small children and she takes care of them and teach them with introductory lessons. Urgen Khando cleans all the classes and cooks for the students. As we serve lunch and tea to students in the school. Manlal Chhetri cooked for the staffs.

STUDENTS ATTENDENCE DURING THE ACADEMIC SESSION:

This year we have eighty seven (87) students all together. Among them twenty five (25) students were admitted this year. Most of the students have given 100% attendance during this session. Few students couldn't give full attendance because of some household works as well as illness and moving to other places for summer camp. There are thirty two (32) students in Nursery Class that is E.C D, where twenty four children were admitted this year. There are fifteen (15) students in class K.G with one drop out. Ten (10) students in class one, Fourteen (14) students in class Two, Five (5) students in class Three with one drop out, three (3) students in class Four two drop out, Four (4) students in class Five and four students (4) students in class Six. This year we have one student from Karang School. We have four drop outs this year and one small boy passed away suddenly. Where some of the dropout have joined the monastery as monks in Namdroling Monastery in India and one girl She is helping her mother.

Regarding the time table it's always same as usual.

EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:

As usual we have games, singing and dancing activities after the school every day and on Friday after 12:00 noon we have some cleaning works inside and outside the school compound. We also have other activities such as drawing, coloring, reciting of poems etc and advices from headmaster regarding the hygienic habits and maintaining the cleanliness. Some time we do have movie time with students. The cup movie of the little monk fan of football has been their favorite.

Dawa Dhondup, Kunsang Lhamo and Dawa Wangmo were our main dance and singing teachers for the students. This year we have taken part in all school students talent exchange program organized by the Namdo school and we found it is very good for all the students and teachers too. We also have a one day teacher and students picnic program combined with the karang school. During the inter school students talent exchange program we had programs like football match, dancing, singing, rally race, sack race, reading, writing, Drawing and poem reciting among the students. Next year also we will have these programs. And we hope that the local Gov may also support us.

EXAMINATION REPORT:

Every year we conduct two exams of full marks 40 for the first half and 60 full marks for the second half exam which becomes 100 full marks in total. We have taken the first half annual examination from 12th of August to 18th of August and most of the students have done very well. And second half

annual examination was conducted on 18th of October and we have final result on 26th of October.

We have good enough result from our students and most of the students have done well and came out with flying colors. Some of them haven't done well and we have decided to let them repeat the same class since we have lots of pressure from the Hostler in Kathmandu stating that our students coming from the village are not able to cope with the students in Kathmandu.

THE WORK OF SCHOOL MANAGEMENT COMMETTEE:

There weren't any changes in the SMC this year. All the members are same which were formed last year. There was no any special works from the SMC but they all took very active part in most of the school activities and functions. Reroofing was all done through the School Management committee and all the responsibility was taken by the chairman Te- Gyaltsen Gurung. For the improvement of drinking water facility of the school they have approached the local Gov of Saldang and we are hopeful that they will do something along with the drinking water project of the village. Two room blocks was also made under the responsibility of SMC but due to lack of timber it is not complete yet.

VILLAGER'S CONDRIBUTION FOR THE SCHOOL:

As part from the villagers contribution, they are always giving 50kg of cow dung for the staffs and 25kg of cow dung for the students. They were helpful to school whenever we need their help and support.
