**OVER ALL REVIEW REPORT OF SESSION 2019**

Summer session of the year 2019 was started from 28<sup>th</sup> of April 2019 and ended the session on 30<sup>th</sup> of October 2019 as final result day and officially closed the school on 2<sup>nd</sup> of November 2019. We enrolled this session with 77 total number of students and 11 staffs. In overall we have good and successful session with lots of celebrations and programs. More interestingly after the training from REED NEPAL, my entire project staffs took very keen on making the so learned techniques effectively applicable in their respective classes with their subjects. Which made me happy to see involvement of both the children and teachers together. All my staffs have done their best in making materials related with their subject matters and on behalf of the project, we have provided all the materials needed to make teaching materials for the teachers as directed by the REED Nepal instructors.

This year our school took part in the inter school gathering program organized by Komasa school which is financially supported by Shey Phoksundo Rural Municipality. During the program, we have activities like inter school football match for teachers, inter school dance, songs, reading, writing, poem reciting, relay race, spoon race, sack race etc among the students.

On 18 of September 2019, we celebrated the 20<sup>th</sup> years of anniversary in the presence of our valued sponsors Michel and his brother with the sponsor team of Namdo school and many other foreign friends from Canada. We have invited other guests such as chairmen of all the wards of nearby villages, coordinators of all the projects and headmasters of all the schools. Even though the program was of one day and short, it was successful enough and we were able to give recognition certificates to our valued sponsors of Shelri Drugdra.

This year also we have various government and project visitors to see the progress of the school as follow up from EGRP and REED Nepal. We got positive feedbacks from them and we also have done our best of our ability.

As usual, this year also we have taken two examinations to see how the students are doing with their studies that is first examinations is of 40 marks and second examination is of 60 marks which in aggregate makes 100 in total.

In overall we have good and very much satisfactory results from our students. As compared with the examination result of last year, we found this year's result was more satisfactory and we found very less number of students who could not do well.

This year also we have three students coming Kathmandu for their further study.

From the above mentioned staffs, Gyanu Gurung being the headmaster took over the responsibility of taking care of the administration of the school and dealing with the government activities related works.

Manlal chhetri who is the replacement of Pratap Rokaya taught the Nepali social study lesson, Manlal Budha taught the Nepali language lesson, Nishana Dharala taught and taken care of the small children of Nursery, Pema Wangyal taught science lesson and is also responsibility of taking care of the administrative whenever Gyanu Gurung is not in the school and help him during time of need and is also responsible for dealing with the foreign sponsors and visitors. Kunsang Lhamo taught health and physical education and also songs and dance to the children. Dawa Wangmo taught English language class, Dawa Dhondup taught mathematics lesson, Dawa Tsetan taught Tibetan lesson. Jhamuna shai cooked food for the staffs and Urgen Khando cooked food for the children because we serve lunch and evening tea to our children in the school with the help of our sponsors and some support from the District Education.

### STUDENTS ATTENDANCE DURING THE SESSION 2019

This year we enrolled the new session of 2019 with seventy seven (77) total number of students. Among them twelve (12) students were

admitted this year. Almost all the students have given 100% attendance during this session. Some of them were absent for few days after the seasonal breaks due to lack of elder people in the village to take care of them.

There are twenty seven(27) students in the grade Nursery, twelve(12)students in grade KG, eleven(11) students in grade one, twelve(12) students in grade two, six(6) students in grade three, three(3) students in grade four, three(3) students in grade five and three(3) students in grade six respectively.

We have three drop outs this year and they have joined monastic education in Kathmandu and we lost one of our very good student of class five in an avalanche with two other local of saldang village.

Daily routine is same all the time but I changed the routine every year after the second week of October because it becomes too cold for the small children to wake up early in the morning and it becomes difficult to stay in the class room due to cold.

### EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

After 4:15 PM that is after the evening prayer and the evening tea, we have dancing and singing practice with the students by our dance teachers Kunsang Lhamo and Dawa Dhondup. Beside dancing and singing, we have sports training such as football, relay race, 100 m race, sack race for the inter school competition.

From this year we have offline wifi connection education where we can find many books, interesting course related videos, stories book, and many other teaching techniques for the staffs. It was financially supported by the local government with four laptops.

Beside these, every Friday all my staffs and senior students joined hands to improve the play ground of the school by constructing stone wall from the base and we will continue with that next year also.

## EXAMINATION REPORT

Same as every year, we have taken two examinations as this year also. We have conducted the first terminal examination from the 18<sup>th</sup> of August till the 25<sup>th</sup> of August 2019 with full marks of 40. And we have conducted the final terminal examination from 22<sup>nd</sup> of October till 28<sup>th</sup> of October 2019 and we have the final result day on 30<sup>th</sup> of October and closed the school officially from 2<sup>nd</sup> of November 2019.

We have found good and satisfactory result from our students and as compared to the last year, we found better result this year. There are few students who couldn't do well, so we have decided to let them repeat the class again and other who have done well are all promoted to next grade.

This year we have three students coming Kathmandu for their further study and two of our summer teachers have stayed in the village to teach winter classes with the revision of the summer session which is very useful for the students.

As usual, the villagers have contributed 50 kg /student of fire wood for the staff and 25kg /student for the mid day meal as their contribution for the school. So many of them have contributed green vegetables, potatoes , radish for the staff and also for the children food.

Beside these, there are many people who have help us to manage the school programs and meetings which means lots to us.

So, I feel that the local villagers are also very positive towards the school and are ready to help us in time of need.

## OUT COME OF SHELRI DRUGDRA SINCE ITS ESTABLISHMENT

After Crystal Mountain, Shelri Drugdra is the second school in upper Dolpo initiated with the help of foreign aid. After 20 years of its establishment, its has given lots of good products for upper Dolpo. Now almost all the school in Shey Phoksundo Rural Municipality has teachers which are product of Shree shelri Drugdra. We have more than five nurses, three bankers and also Health Assistant(HA) as its product now working in Shey phoksundo Rural Municipality benefitting the local community which means lots to us.

## CONTRIBUTION ON BEHALF OF GOVERNMENT

As contribution from the local government, they have provided us funds to buy offline server(ole Nepal) company, along with four laptops for the school where allocated amount was Rs300000/

And there was mid day meal program from the District Education where allocated amount was Rs 135000/

In total Rs 435000/ is part of government contribution for the school.

Lastly, this year session was very good and successful with the help of generous sponsors. I hope we will have the same session next year that is 2020 also.
